Through the convenience of EFT (electronic funds transfer), you can authorize your bank to automatically transfer your monthly contribution from your checking or savings account to RMM. It's easy to set up, and it's a secure and reliable way to continue or increase your participation in RMM's ministry. Your contributions will show up on your monthly bank statement. In January of every year, we will send you a statement of your RMM giving history that you can use for tax purposes. You can discontinue the program at any time.

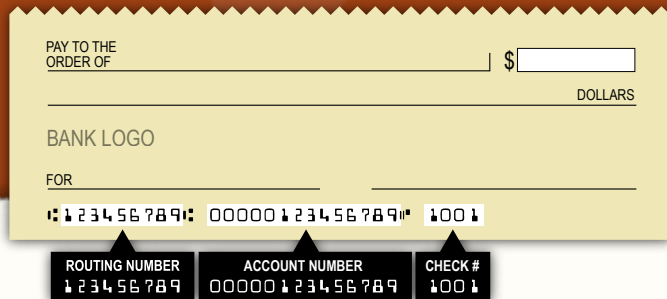


**How does it work?** When you enroll in the program, your contribution is electronically transferred from your bank account to RMM's account on a monthly basis.

**Is it safe?** There is actually less risk with electronic funds transfer than with a check. An EFT contribution cannot be stolen or lost in the mail. It is an extremely accurate and reliable process.

**What are the advantages?** Electronic contributions make it easy to give regularly and eliminate the time and work that it takes to remember to write and send a check each month. RMM benefits from the regularity of the giving (we know how to plan) and it saves us money since we don't need to handle and process your check.

**How do I locate my bank account and routing numbers?** These numbers are located on the bottom of each of your checks. See below.



Your contribution will always be made on the date that you select (either the 10th or the 25th). You can simply record your contribution in your check register on that date. The transfer will also appear on your bank statement, which can serve as proof of your contribution.

**Will I receive a receipt?** Yes. These contributions are tax-deductible. In January of every year, we will send you a statement of your RMM giving history that you can use for tax purposes. In addition, you may contact our office at any time to request a summarized statement of your giving.

**What if I need to amend my original EFT agreement?** If you change bank accounts or wish to increase/decrease your monthly contribution, simply notify RMM and we will send you a new authorization form.
